The main purpose is to introduce CYBERSECURITY to youth and youth workers, teach them the main components of cybersecurity, in a fun, non-formal and interactive way, in collaboration with cybersecurity experts.

ABOUT ANKARA

Ankara is the capital city of <u>Turkey</u> and the second largest city in the country after <u>Istanbul</u>. It is located at the heart of Turkey with the population around 6 million. Ankara is the administrative center of Turkey and a huge university town with 10 public and 14 private universities, where there are nearly 330.000 university students.

Ankara has a symbolic significance for the secular Turks. It is the place where a new era for the Turkish people started. It is a symbol for independence, development and Western values.

Ankara has its own international airport (Esenboğa Havaalanı), which is located just outside of the city center and offers regular flights to and from many major European and international destinations. Reaching to the city center is around 25-30 minutes by bus or taxi (there is no metro from airport).

Transportation: The city has a dense public bus network, a two-line subway called Ankara Metrosu and a single line suburban railway called Ankara Banliyö Treni. For tourists, Ankara's public transit system, particularly the public bus network, can be difficult to figure out because maps are rare and all information is in Turkish and buses and metros tend to be very crowded during rush hour, especially on Mondays and Fridays.
